Board Items:

o eMail vote

- Since December 2015 Board meeting, side discussions occurred regarding formal presentation of an award and gift to Past President Dave Swope at the January 2016 membership meeting.
- Board consensus (excluding Dave Swope) agreed to solicit cash donations from Chapter members and friends toward the purchase of a gift card, with a goal of \$500.
- Based on donations not reaching \$500 (\$305 were raised), Richard Lewis suggested the balance toward a \$500 gift card (\$195) be paid by chapter funds. The request was put to a Board vote (excluding Dave Swope due to his pecuniary interest) via email, resulting in a tie 4 votes in favor; 4 votes against. Based on lack of reaching a majority in favor, chapter funds were not expended toward the gift card purchase.
- Vice President resignation Richard Lewis tendered his resignation as Chapter Vice President effective January 20, 2016, via email.
- Treasurer's report: Latest report reviewed by those in attendance. Following discussion, consensus agreement that treasurer's reports will be available at the membership meetings; but will only be reviewed for approval at the Board meetings. Motion to approve the Treasurer's report by Amy Stum, 2nd by Chris Plesic. All approved.
- Meeting minutes: October 2015 & January 2016 minutes raised; no revisions. Approved as published.
- Chapter Incorporation update: Attorney Stone provided the chapter with a copy of the filed Articles of Incorporation
 and letter from the Department of State. Advertising costs are pending; additional information to be provided by
 Attorney Stone's office.
